

Insperity Championship E-Notes

March 5, 2013

- With 56 days to go before the tournament celebrates its 10th anniversary, some early player commitments are starting to come in. Currently, six of the past champions have officially gone through the commitment process: **Mark McNulty** (2004), **Jay Haas** (2006), **Bernhard Langer** (2007, 2008), **John Cook** (2009), **Brad Faxon** (2011) and **Fred Funk** (2012). All champions are expected to compete in the April 29-May 5 event, including 2010 champion **Fred Couples**.
- Speaking of champions. Other than, **Bernhard Langer**, the only champion to successfully defend his title with wins in 2007 and 2008, what champion had the best performance the following year after victory? **Jay Haas** was T4 in 2007 and Langer was T4 in 2009.
- For the third time in its nine-year history, the Insperity Championship presented by UnitedHealthcare was recognized as one of the top events on the Champions Tour schedule. This year, the tournament received The Players Award for having "the best of everything" for players, sponsors and spectators. In 2008, the tournament received the President's Award as the best overall event and in 2011 was honored with the President's Award for Excellence in Achievement.
- Four champions of the Insperity Championship presented by UnitedHealthcare—Jay Haas,
 Bernhard Langer, Brad Faxon and Fred Funk-- have a combined seven total rounds of bogey-free golf on their way to victory. By the way, they are the only champions to record bogey-free rounds. Langer leads the group with three rounds without a bogey.
- After three official events in 2013 **Bernhard Langer**, a two-time champion in Houston, holds a 58-point lead in the Charles Schwab Cup.
