All-Star Field Set to Tee it Up at Insperity Invitational in The Woodlands
Couples, Montgomerie, Langer, Price, and Greats of Golf lead legends of the game into Texas

THE WOODLANDS, TX—Seven World Golf Hall of Fame members. The Champions Tour Player-of-the-Year for each of the last eight seasons. The first Mexican to win on the PGA TOUR's Champions Tour. The Greats of Golf. All of these golf legends have confirmed to tee it up at the 2014 Insperity Invitational presented by UnitedHealthcare, ensuring the *Tradition of Excellence* continues at The Woodlands Country Club Tournament Course, April 28 – May 4, 2014.

Fred Couples, Colin Montgomerie, Bernhard Langer, Nick Price, Tom Kite, Curtis Strange, and Ben Crenshaw will headline an 81-man field, who are en route to The Woodlands, TX for the first of two Champions Tour events in Texas this year.

The impressive line-up of the game's greatest names also includes 29 of the top-30 from last year's money list, and 59 players that have combined to win more than 400 PGA TOUR events, including 16 professionals who have combined for 19 major championships.

While **Esteban Toledo** will look to successfully defend his Insperity Invitational title, Montgomerie and **Jeff Maggert** will lead a list of impressive names making their first appearance at the seventh of 24 events on the 2014 Champions Tour. Both have strong connections to the area. Montgomerie graduated from Houston Baptist University in 1987 following three straight NCAA Tournament appearances, while Jeff Maggert is a resident of The Woodlands community. Maggert will try to become the first player to win his first two career starts since Bruce Fleisher won the 1999 Royal Caribbean Classic and the American Express Invitational. Maggert won his Champions Tour debut one month ago in Mississippi. Other notable new faces this year include three of golf's top international stars who received invites to this year's Tournament based on winning the Order of Merit on their respective Tours. **Ahmad Bateman** – Asian Seniors Tour, **David Merriman** – PGA Australian Legends Tour, and **Paul Wesselingh** – European Senior Tour will make their first appearance at the Insperity Invitational. Champions Tour rookie from the United States, **Billy Andrade**, will also look for his first victory.

“Traditionally, we have been privileged to welcome one of the strongest fields each year on the Champions Tour,” said Bryan Naugle, executive director, Insperity Invitational. “Thanks to the vision and commitment of our title partner, Insperity, our new status as an Invitational tournament, one of the best tests of golf on the Champions Tour, and the return of the 3M Oil & Gas Greats of Golf competition, Houston golf fans now have the opportunity to witness the best tournament yet in our 11-year history.”

Fans attending this year's tournament will have the rare chance to see **Arnold Palmer, Jack Nicklaus, Gary Player** and **Lee Trevino** tee it up in a special competition, Saturday afternoon of tournament week at The Woodlands Country Club Tournament Course.

For the past two years, thousands of fans have lined the fairways to watch one of the year's best events in golf as a collection of the game's greatest legends share laughter and competition during one of the best Champions Tour events on the calendar. Once again the “Big Four” along with **Johnny Miller, Raymond Floyd, Don January, David Graham, Tony Jacklin** and **Dave Stockton** will compete in the 3M Oil & Gas Greats of Golf competition. Palmer will not compete this year. However, he will be in attendance and serve as an honorary chairman for the event.

This legendary and world-class group of the game's greatest players - which includes eight World Golf Hall of Fame members who have combined for more than 300 PGA TOUR victories, over 50 major championships and more than 150 Champions Tour titles - will tee off following the last tee time of the official competition. These nine players will be grouped in threesomes and will play an 18-hole scramble format.

The Insperity Invitational offers free grounds only admission tickets courtesy of Insperity, MD Anderson Cancer Center, Woodforest National Bank and HP. The grounds ticket also includes free parking and shuttle service.
