

FINAL ROUND INTERVIEW: IAN WOOSNAM
Sunday, May 3, 2015



Q. 68, no bogeys, pretty good.

IAN WOOSNAM: Yeah, I played pretty good today. Missed a few putts as well, but that was a good one there at the end there. It was a bit of a battle there playing into the wind the last few holes, but got through it. Hit a great shot into the last hole, we had a really bad lie. Well, it wasn't the lie, it was my feet. It was 50/50 whether I could get a drop, so we never mark anything in the rough so had to get on with it. It was a great upanddown, decided to putt it from just off the edge of the green.

Q. You got off to three birdies in the first six holes to really jump in it. Did you have an idea what was going on as the day went on?

IAN WOOSNAM: Well, you know, I just tried to not look at the board too much, just tried to do the best I possibly could and see what happened from there. Obviously as I came down the stretch I could see what was going on. Missed a couple short putts. I had a good chance on No. 14 and 15, missed them both. I could have really sealed it up then if I had rolled in two putts, but we'll see what happens.

Q. How's your back?

IAN WOOSNAM: Today's been better. The first two days I did well to play. Last night I just took some more antiinflammatory and it's settled down quite a bit. But I got up early and took them earlier to go into effect, so it's a lot better, yeah.

Q. Any red wine to go with that?

IAN WOOSNAM: No, just a bit of saki, Japanese saki. Worked last time.
