

FINAL ROUND INTERVIEW: KENNY PERRY

Q. We don't know what's going to happen from here on, but I guess Freddie told me your back went on the sixth green; actually had a pretty good back nine.

KENNY PERRY: Took eight Advil, took I'm in a lot of pain. I don't want to stiffen up. If there's a playoff, I'm in trouble, so I've got to figure out I'm going to go over here and just kind of stand on the range and swing a few. But I hit the ball flawlessly. It didn't bother me to there's one tender spot right where I bend over where it takes me to my knees. I just bent over to pick up my putter and it took me out. I don't know what I did, something hit a nerve and I fell to the ground. But I hit the ball okay. I can hit a golf ball, but I just I can't hardly stand and bend. So this is kind of hard on me just standing right here. But all in all it was a great day. I hit great iron shots, drove it nice, putted it nice. I guess I need a hurt back more often.

Q. Woosie has a hurt back, too. He was telling us about it yesterday.

KENNY PERRY: Yeah. Well, we're old.

Q. What was your mindset coming today?

KENNY PERRY: Well, you know, you're in the rocking chair in my position. All you've got to do is try to go low and that's normally not enough. It's a free swinging position. It was fun. I mean, I probably played 15 Tour events here and

OLIN BROWNE: Don't believe him, it was pure luck.

KENNY PERRY: Yeah, he watched it. So I know this course very well. I've played a lot of rounds here. And the wind's up today, it's dicey out there. I hit a lot of quality iron shots coming in.
