

FINAL ROUND INTERVIEW: TOM LEHMAN

Q. Just about sort of the day. I mean, you had an indifferent front nine but a pretty good back nine.

TOM LEHMAN: Yeah, made a few putts. It was hard, hard with the wind blowing to get the right reads. I misread some putts. But when you win, you have to make more putts than I made. I hit it really well, I just didn't get the ball in the hole.

Q. Quickly about the playoff, second shot.

TOM LEHMAN: Yeah, I dropped my 3iron out of the bag this week and I had like 200 over the water into the wind so I didn't have a club for the shot so I tried to hit a really hard 4iron and I kind of got ahead of it and came off it. It's kind of a bad yardage for me. I kind of necked my tee shot a little bit and (inaudible.)

Q. You've never finished out of the Top 10 in this event.

TOM LEHMAN: Is that right?

Q. The Woodlands is pretty good.

TOM LEHMAN: I think I've got a third and now two seconds. I like the course. It's a ball strikers golf course. You have to hit the ball really well to get it close to these pins. It kind of plays to my strengths.
