

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW: MIKE GOODES
May 7, 2016



MIKE GOODES: Just a little tougher today, a little more wind. Hit the ball, drove the ball great all day. Just didn't make any birdies. Two bogeys, two birdies. You know, I would like I didn't hit my irons quite as good today, didn't have as good of birdie putts all day, and just harder to make them. Some days it's like that.

Q. How much different was the wind?

MIKE GOODES: It was a good five or more miles per hour harder and it just grabs the ball sometimes, a little gusty, especially the last nine it was a little more gusty. It was challenging. I hit a good shot on 14 where I made bogey and it must have caught a little gust and it plugged in the top lip of the bunker. I thought I hit a great tee shot, iron, but that's the way it is. It's hard to judge it right all the time.

Q. Jeff was saying it was kind of changing direction a little bit, too?

MIKE GOODES: It moved around, too. It was funny. You just, you feel it in your face and you look at flags and they're going in the opposite direction. So it was tricky out there, and it's such a good golf course anyway.

Q. You're right there.

MIKE GOODES: Yeah, yeah. I had three good birdie putts on the last three holes and didn't make any of them. I would love to have made one of them. Maybe I'll make them tomorrow.

Q. It's just, it's stacked in there, it's anybody's game?

MIKE GOODES: A lot of people right there. Yeah, somebody will come out and shoot 4, 5, 6 under or something like that. There will be a lot of people in contention tomorrow.

Q. Is that a fun kind of day?

MIKE GOODES: Not for me.

Q. It's absolutely more fun when you're up by 10, I know that.

MIKE GOODES: You know, I play to want to have a chance on the last nine holes on Sunday. I want to play as good as I can and if I do that, I'll have an opportunity last several holes come tomorrow and that's all I can ask for, see what happens there.

Q. Any great saves out there or anything today?

MIKE GOODES: I made a really good save on 8. I missed the green to the right, didn't hit a great chip and knocked about 15 feet by the hole and made it. That one, I just birdied 6 and 7 and it kind of kept the round going. To me it was gave me some more oxygen to live on. That was a good one.

Q. When are you going to break out the Make America Great Again hat?

MIKE GOODES: I don't think I need to.

Q. Have you got a pink shirt for tomorrow?
