John Daly Holds Pre-Tournament Interview Opportunity on Wednesday

The PGA TOUR Champions' newest star, John Daly, will be in the Media Center interview room on Wednesday at 9:30 a.m. for his lone pre-tournament media opportunity.

The two-time major winner, who turned 50 on April 28, will make his PGA TOUR Champions debut this week at the Insperity Invitational.

Ian Woosnam Set to Defend Insperity Invitational Title

Ian Woosnam will look to join Bernhard Langer as the only players in tournament history to successfully defend a title at the Insperity Invitational.

Woosnam captured his lone PGA TOUR Champions title one year ago when he defeated Tom Lehman and Kenny Perry on the first playoff hole. Woosnam's 30-foot birdie putt on the first extra hole did the trick, and marked the third time in Insperity Invitational history a playoff was needed to decide a champion. The victory also made Woosnam the fourth player in tournament history to make the Insperity Invitational his first PGA TOUR Champions victory. Others included: Bernhard Langer (2007), Brad Faxon (2011), and Esteban Toledo (2013).

Best of the Best Arrive in The Woodlands

The 2016 Insperity Invitational features six members of the World Golf Hall of Fame including: Tom Kite, Mark O'Meara, Curtis Strange, Colin Montgomerie, Sandy Lyle, and Larry Nelson

Along with defending champion, Ian Woosnam, there will be seven other past winners of Houston's PGA TOUR Champions event—Larry Nelson (2004), Mark McNulty (2005), Jay Haas (2006), John Cook (2009), Brad Faxon (2011), Fred Funk (2012) and Esteban Toledo (2013).

"The field for this year's tournament will once again be a fantastic combination of golf's legends, new PGA TOUR Champions members, Hall of Fame members and the best players in the world age 50 and over," said Bryan Naugle, Executive Director of the Insperity Invitational. "We are excited with all aspects of the tournament both on and off the golf course. The fans in the Houston area are in for a real treat as this annual tradition continues."

There are eight categories of eligibility in the invitational format, making this event unique on the PGA TOUR Champions schedule. This marks the third year the tournament has used this innovative qualifying method.

In addition to this legendary group of players, the top 20 players from the 2016 PGA TOUR Champions money list who are scheduled to compete include such players as Billy Andrade, Joe Durant, Kevin Sutherland, Michael Allen, Scott Dunlap, Paul Goydos, Woody Austin, Duffy Waldorf, Bart Bryant, Jeff Sluman, Kirk Triplett, Wes Short, Jr., Stephen Ames, Jerry Smith and Gene Sauers.

From the All-Time money list category, some of the players committed include: Loren Roberts, Scott Verplank, Scott Hoch, Corey Pavin, Rocco Mediate, Craig Stadler, John Huston and Jesper Parnevik.

Also qualifying for the Insuperity Invitational by virtue of winning a Champions Tour major in the last five years are Olin Browne, Roger Chapman, Russ Cochran, Joe Daley, Tom Lehman, David Frost, Jeff Maggert, Kenny Perry and Mark Wiebe.

Future Stars Highlight Tuesday’s Junior Golf Day at the Insuperity Invitational

The 13th anniversary of the Insuperity Invitational will heat up on Tuesday when 36 junior golfers (18 girls and 18 boys), ages seven-to-17, will tee it up on the back nine with Champions Tour professionals in Zaxby’s Junior Pro-Am.

The juniors, who will gain the full experience of a Tour player under the ropes, qualified to take part in the event through their finish in the spring junior championships conducted by the Southern Texas PGA.

Did You Know?

- The first 1,000 spectators through the main gate on Friday, Saturday and Sunday will get a gift item as a souvenir. The first 1,000 fans on Friday will receive a John Daly bobblehead doll to celebrate the two-time major winner’s PGA TOUR Champions debut;
- The Tournament Course yielded just 44 rounds below 70 in 2015 with the par-4, 5th hole ranking as the most difficult. The average score over the three rounds in 2015 was 72.376;
- This year’s tournament could be decided on the 17th green. In the eight years the Insuperity Invitational has been held at The Woodlands Country Club Tournament Course – the 17th hole has ranked as the most difficult with a stroke average of 4.672;
- Michael Allen and Fred Couples share the low round at The Tournament Course with 63s. Allen fired the 9-under-par score in the opening round of the 2011 event, while Couples carded the same score in the final round of the 2010 tournament where he was crowned champion;
- Major League Baseball’s 11-time All-Star, and two-time World Series champion – Roger Clemens, teed it up in Monday’s UnitedHealthcare Pro-Am.
