Ian Woosnam Set to Defend Insperity Invitational Title

Ian Woosnam will set out to defend his 2015 Insperity Invitational title on Friday at The Woodlands Country Club Tournament Course.

The former European Ryder Cup Captain survived 54 holes plus one extra last year to win his first PGA TOUR Champions title in Texas, defeating Tom Lehman and Kenny Perry on the first extra hole. The ‘Wee Welshman’ nailed a 30-foot birdie putt on the first playoff hole to decide the 2015 championship.

“That was a very important win for me to make me exempt for the year, and this year. It was a big thing I had been working on for six months. I did a lot of work on my swing and it paid off,” said Woosnam. “This is just one of them golf courses for me. It just seems to fit my eye a little better and maybe that’s why I play better here.”

Woosnam will tee off at 12:40 p.m. playing alongside Mark O’Meara and Woody Austin.

What the Pros are Saying in the Media Center

“I have a bit of a bad back and struggling a little bit with the game. I’m just looking forward to the sort of golf course I seem to play pretty good on. Every time you play well on a golf course it gives you confidence.”

“I think someone like John Daly is very flamboyant, is great fun and he pulls the crowd. I imagine the crowds are going to be huge this week. It’s great to have him, and the excitement of having him playing. He’s a big character. I remember playing with him four days in a row at the Masters. He said he spent more time (that week) with me than he spent with his wife. And that’s all of them.”

“Switching putters on Sunday has been the key. The game is a putting contest and that’s the weakest part of my game, and now it seems if I switch putters on Sunday that gives me a little added boost. I did it for all three of my wins.”

“It’s another one of those courses I did pretty well on back in the day. It’s a good driver’s golf course. You’ve got to hit some good drives and keep it in play. You can get yourself in trouble hitting it offline here. It is a good track. I’ve got a good feel for it.”

“John Daly is a needle mover. We need that out here – he’s someone people want to come and watch. They don’t want to come out and see me – a journeyman – and I understand that. It is important to have, what we call, the needlemovers, come and play our Tour. We haven’t had enough of that so we need John Daly to come out.”

“I won’t apologize for winning. I’m a realist though and I understand this Tour was not built for me to have the greatest life in the world. This Tour was built so that guys like Jack, Arnold, Gary, Lee – those guys – were still in the public’s eye and we could still see them play golf, and I understand that. That’s why we will struggle to get people (fans) to come out if we don’t have those types of guys on our Tour anymore. We need the needlemovers – the John Dalys.”
