

**BART BRYANT ( -10)**

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**Q. Great playing today. Your back nine was really where you were strong. Can you talk about that a little bit?**

**BART BRYANT:** Yeah, like I said, I just hit the ball well. I mean, it was just solid. I wasn't worried about hitting thin shots or fat shots, everything was just on the button. I was hitting it pretty straight. I managed my game well and I just tried to really be patient all week. You know, I just kept thinking, I'm going to make some putts, I'm going to make some putts. But I stuffed it in there a lot this week really close where I didn't have to make them. I was fortunate to make a putt on the last hole. I didn't hit it very good, but finally one went in, so it was nice and maybe I'll get lucky and get in a playoff.

**Q. Are you surprised that you're here?**

**BART BRYANT:** I'm real surprised. I thought it would be -- you know, starting the day, I really thought it would be 13 or 14. Then while I was going around the back, I said, man, if I can get it to 12, we've got a chance, you know, for a playoff, maybe even win it outright. Just couldn't quite -- just couldn't quite get it done. I had the putts to do it, I just didn't do it.
